A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 4074**

2 In line 5, delete “5” and insert “3”.

3 In line 17, delete “6” and insert “4”.

4 In line 31, delete “7” and insert “5”.

5 In line 45, delete “8” and insert “6”.

6 On page 3, line 17, delete “9” and insert “7”.

7 On page 4, line 2, delete “10” and insert “8”.

8 In line 15, delete “11” and insert “9”.

9 In line 28, delete “12” and insert “10”.

10 Delete lines 29 through 32 and insert:

11 **“SECTION 11. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-**  
12 **ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Criminal Justice Commis-**  
13 **sion, for the biennium ending June 30, 2023, out of the General Fund,**  
14 **the amount of \$6,000,000, for deposit into the Illegal Marijuana Market**  
15 **Enforcement Grant Program Fund established under section 15, chap-**  
16 **ter 103, Oregon Laws 2018, for the purpose of responding to**  
17 **humanitarian crises associated with unlawful marijuana cultivation**  
18 **and distribution operations.**

19 **“SECTION 12. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**  
20 **the limitation on expenditures established by section 3, chapter 379,**  
21 **Oregon Laws 2021, for the biennium ending June 30, 2023, as the max-**

1 **imum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other reve-**  
2  **nues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds**  
3  **and federal funds, collected or received by the Oregon Criminal Justice**  
4  **Commission, is increased by \$6,000,000, for additional grants under the**  
5  **Illegal Marijuana Market Enforcement Grant Program established**  
6  **under section 13, chapter 103, Oregon Laws 2018, for financial assist-**  
7  **ance to community-based organizations that are responding to the**  
8  **humanitarian crises associated with unlawful marijuana cultivation**  
9  **and distribution operations.**

10 **“SECTION 13. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**  
11  **the limitation on expenditures established by section 3, chapter 379,**  
12  **Oregon Laws 2021, for the biennium ending June 30, 2023, as the max-**  
13  **imum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other reve-**  
14  **nues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds**  
15  **and federal funds, collected or received by the Oregon Criminal Justice**  
16  **Commission, is increased by \$130,978.**

17 **“SECTION 14. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**  
18  **the limitation on expenditures established by section 1 (1), chapter 640,**  
19  **Oregon Laws 2021, for the biennium ending June 30, 2023, as the max-**  
20  **imum limit for payment of fees, moneys or other revenues, including**  
21  **Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds**  
22  **collected or received by the Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission**  
23  **for administrative expenses, is increased by \$155,127.”.**

25 In line 34, delete “7” and insert “5”.

26 In line 39, delete “5 to 7” and insert “3 to 5”.

27 In line 40, delete “15” and insert “16”.

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
