**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 1538**

1 On page 4 of the printed bill, delete lines 15 through 18 and insert:

2 **“SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the**
3 **General Fund appropriation made to the Oregon Health Authority by**
4 **section 1 (1), chapter 668, Oregon Laws 2021, for the biennium ending**
5 **June 30, 2023, for health systems, health policy and analytics, and**
6 **public health, is increased by \$314,543 for the purpose of carrying out**
7 **section 1 of this 2022 Act.**

8 **“SECTION 5. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
9 **the limitation on expenditures established by section 2 (4), chapter 668,**
10 **Oregon Laws 2021, for the biennium ending June 30, 2023, as the max-**
11 **imum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other reve-**
12 **nues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, tobacco tax receipts,**
13 **marijuana tax receipts, beer and wine tax receipts, provider taxes and**
14 **Medicare receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not**
15 **described in section 2, chapter 668, Oregon Laws 2021, collected or re-**
16 **ceived by the Oregon Health Authority, for shared administrative**
17 **services, is increased by \$394,949 for the purpose of carrying out sec-**
18 **tion 1 of this 2022 Act.**

19 **“SECTION 6. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
20 **the limitation on expenditures established by section 5 (1), chapter 668,**
21 **Oregon Laws 2021, for the biennium ending June 30, 2023, as the max-**

1 **imum limit for payment of expenses from federal funds, excluding**
2 **federal funds described in section 2, chapter 668, Oregon Laws 2021,**
3 **collected or received by the Oregon Health Authority, for health sys-**
4 **tems, health policy and analytics, and public health, is increased by**
5 **\$808,628 for the purpose of carrying out section 1 of this 2022 Act.”.**

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
