- "656.232. (1) If a beneficiary is [an alien] a noncitizen residing outside
- of the United States or its dependencies, payment of the sums due such
 - beneficiary may, in the discretion of the Director of the Department of
- 12 Consumer and Business Services, be made to the consul general of the
- country in which such beneficiary resides on behalf of the beneficiary. The
- receipt of the consul general to the director for the amounts thus paid shall
- be a full and sufficient receipt for the payment of the funds thus due the
- 16 beneficiary.
- "(2) All benefit rights shall be canceled upon the commencement of a state
- 18 of war between the United States and the country of a beneficiary's
- 19 domicile.".
