**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
B-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 1536
(INCLUDING AMENDMENTS TO RESOLVE CONFLICTS)**

1 On page 1 of the printed B-engrossed bill, line 3, after the semicolon in-
2 sert “repealing sections 1 and 1a, chapter ___, Oregon Laws 2022 (Enrolled
3 Senate Bill 1533);”.

4 On page 21, after line 17, insert:

5 **“SECTION 30a. If Senate Bill 1533 becomes law, section 1, chapter**
6 **___, Oregon Laws 2022 (Enrolled Senate Bill 1533) (amending ORS**
7 **431A.410), is repealed and ORS 431A.410, as amended by section 30 of**
8 **this 2022 Act, is amended to read:**

9 “431A.410. (1) As used in this section[,]:

10 **“(a) ‘Public education provider’ has the meaning given that term**
11 **in ORS 326.545.**

12 **“(b) ‘Smoke filtration system’ means an air filtration system capable of**
13 **removing particulates and other harmful components of wildfire smoke in a**
14 **public building.**

15 **“(2) In consultation and coordination with the Oregon Health Authority,**
16 **the Department of Human Services shall establish and implement a grant**
17 **program that allows local governments, public education providers and**
18 **federally recognized Indian tribes in Oregon to:**

19 **“(a) Establish emergency [*shelters for clean*] spaces that provide cleaner**
20 **air, warming or cooling.**

1 “(b) Equip public buildings with:

2 “(A) Smoke filtration systems so the public buildings may serve as cleaner
3 air spaces during wildfire smoke and other poor air quality events.

4 “(B) Warming or cooling facilities so the public buildings may serve as
5 temperate spaces during dangerously hot or cold conditions.

6 “(3) The department shall require grantees to provide access to the [*shel-*
7 *ters*] **spaces** at no charge.

8 “(4) Warming or cooling [*shelters*] **spaces** or facilities receiving grants
9 under this section shall notify the 2-1-1 system provided for in ORS 403.400
10 to 403.430, regarding the [*shelter’s*] **space’s** location and capacity and shall
11 keep the corporation updated with the [*shelter’s*] **space’s** hours and dates of
12 operation.”.

13 After line 26, insert:

14 **“SECTION 31a. If Senate Bill 1533 becomes law, section 1a, chapter**
15 **___, Oregon Laws 2022 (Enrolled Senate Bill 1533) (amending ORS**
16 **431A.412), is repealed and ORS 431A.412, as amended by section 31 of**
17 **this 2022 Act, is amended to read:**

18 “431A.412. (1) **As used in this section, ‘public education provider’ has**
19 **the meaning given that term in ORS 326.545.**

20 “(2) The Department of Human Services is the lead state agency for [*clean*
21 *air, warming and cooling shelter operations*] **operating spaces that provide**
22 **cleaner air, warming or cooling.** The department shall:

23 “[*1*] (a) Consult and collaborate with the Oregon Health Authority to
24 align practices for voluntary evacuations and emergency sheltering oper-
25 ations.

26 “[*2*] (b) Coordinate with the authority in setting priorities for awarding
27 grants described in ORS 431A.410.

28 “[*3*] (c) Provide support to **the local agencies, public education pro-**
29 **viders and federally recognized Indian tribes in Oregon** that take lead
30 roles in operating and planning [*shelters in the local agencies’ jurisdictions*]

1 **spaces that provide cleaner air, warming or cooling.”.**

2 After line 30, insert:

3 **“SECTION 32a.** If Senate Bill 1533 becomes law, section 32 of this 2022
4 Act is amended to read:

5 **“Sec. 32.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there
6 is appropriated to the Department of Human Services, for the biennium
7 ending June 30, 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$2,000,000, to
8 provide grants for emergency [*shelters*] **spaces** or facilities that include
9 warming or cooling under ORS 431A.410 (2)(a) or (b)(B).”.

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
