As a substitute teacher and tutor for children from Kindergarten through High School, I experienced the emotional stress, loss of selfmotivation, and failure of too many of our children due to the standardized testing that our Department of Education adopted. I witnessed too many quality teachers guit because they could no longer teach a curriculum where they helped their students thrive. It's been devastating, and your committee can help bring back a public educational system that will be student-centered rather than testcentered. For too long now, we have experienced too many of our young people "fall through the cracks;" and we wonder why we have so many societal problems. Education provides the roots for thriving communities! The standardized testing that we have burdened our children with for many years now has not worked.
