A significant portion of what we do is help families find medically competent care in our state. The medical providers who have stepped up to take care of this complex population, are predominately Naturopathic Physicians. Because of this, we are asking for your support on HB 4006.

I have had the opportunity to work with Naturopathic Doctors and appreciate the unique and valuable skill set and approach to care that they offer. I have always found NDs to be professional, knowledgeable and well trained clinically. Most importantly I have witnessed the positive impact on patients' health and wellness that comes from the care NDs provide.
