Testimony of the Confederated Tribes of the Umatilla Indian Reservation House Committee on Environment and Natural Resources HB 4130 – February 2, 2022

HB 4130 is a proactive approach to advancing long term mitigations for the linear impacts to wildlife and habitat connectivity posed by the network of transportation corridors throughout the state.

The persistent and unnecessary loss to big game and other migratory wildlife populations is a threat to our culture and traditions. We believe HB 4130 is a good start to protecting our First Foods while addressing past impacts to wildlife migration and habitat connectivity.
