I strongly support SB 1546 and the establishment of the Elliot State Research Forest. The research forest will consist of lands formerly constituting the Elliott State Forest, creating a contiguous 34,000+-acre, permanent reserve on the west side of the Elliott State Forest, and smaller reserves across the rest of the Forest. Within these reserves, previously logged stands will be restored to again become older forest, thereby increasing the amount of mature and old-growth forest over time.
