I oppose SB 1521. School Boards should have the discretion to hire or fire superintendents as they see fit, as they are an elected body of the people. This bill is in response to parents upset with school boards that are choosing to go along with the OHA, which is itself openly defying the will of thousands of Oregonians that voted against unconstitutional and unscientific mask mandates. The OHA claims to follow the CDC in its rulemaking, but the CDC itself has stated that cloth and surgical masks do not mitigate the spread of covid, and children under 18 as a whole are statistically infallible to covid.
