Thank you for your consideration of HB 4115.

Like most Oregonians, members of the Independent Party of Oregon are greatly concerned with the impact of climate change upon our beloved state. Within our ranks, there are also thousands of members of PERS.

One of the pillars of our party is a commitment to transparency. Another is a deep-seated commitment to the environment, of which climate change represents an absolute existential threat. HB 4115 is a good start at addressing both of these issues for our party and indeed, every Oregonian. As the Committee is well aware, the DivestOregon coalition has been forced to go to great lengths, FOI requests and months of delay to even partly unveil the cloak of secrecy that currently encompasses the investments being made by the Oregon Treasury.

That discussion and debate is simply not possible without full information and HB 4115 is a big step in the right direction by demanding such accountability.

As Oregon's third largest political party, we are hopeful that the members of this Committee, both Republicans and Democrats, can support legislation that is in the interest of ALL Oregonians. Knowledge is power. Give the power to the people by supporting HB 4115 and sending it on to the full House for adoption.
