I recognize this is not an easy decision to make, but farm work is very difficult work that is significantly undercompensated already, and passing HB 4002 would be a step in remedying that.

I urge you to pass farmworker overtime in the 2022 Legislative Session to ensure farmworkers in Oregon are paid fairly for their skilled and essential labor.
