Similarly, 3 weeks ago someone tried to get into my DMV account. I was notified through an email and called the DMV immediately. The agent confirmed that someone had tried to get into my account. He told me that if they would have they could have changed my address and paid a bill. REGISTER TO VOTE in OREGON through the DMV online using My VOTE Portal is all connected to my DMV login.

"Too many cooks in the Kitchen" allowing again another entity be involved in voter registration opens the door to voter fraud, inaccurate voter registration, and removes the rights of the individual to self determine their election rights and which all NEGATIVELY AFFECT VOTER INTEGRITY.

Social Security numbers do not provide any evidence of Oregon residency; Thousand and thousands of Social Security Numbers are stolen and are currently being used fraudulently. This will be another way that Oregon Voters are disenfranchised.
