Establishes COFA Dental Program in Oregon Health Authority to provide dental care to low-income citizens of Pacific Islands in Compact of Free Association who reside in Oregon.

Living islands is a non-profit organization located in Lake Oswego, Oregon, serving the people of Micronesia. Our focus is on bringing education, health, and sustainability to our communities, both here in Oregon and the Pacific Islands regions of Micronesia. Particularly in Oregon, we bring cross-cultural education and awareness about the three island nations under the Compact of Free Association. We also understand the importance and impact of proper health care in doing so.
