Adding taxes during a time of economic uncertainty to provide regular payments to low income individuals will further inflate already unaffordable rent and housing prices for the working class struggling to avoid becoming unhoused. Please consider the consequences of this legislation beyond the immediate appearance of assistance and do not pursue a proposal that would further burden our communities.
