If HB 4002 were to pass it would impact my current & future employees & their families in a negative way. They could possibly receive less hours than their current scheduled work week, which could mean less take-home pay for them. We would need to hire more employees to cover the hours needed to operate the 24/7 scheduled work week to avoid paying overtime. This not only affects the current employees but also myself, as the owner and our day to day cost of operations. This could also jeopardize the housing that is provided for 70% of our employees & their families. Finding good, hard working, capable employees to do the amount of work needed is difficult & hard to find during this time.
