I work in the dairy industry in Oregon and Washington, so I have heard this from workers and owners. This is a 24 hour a day business which includes tending to live animals that are eating, birthing, and milking. This type of business makes scheduling unique. Many shifts are not based on a 7-day work week but on a rotating set of days on and then set days off.

Workers in Washington have been displeased with reduced hours and/or less days off and fewer hours during regular work days.
