HB4002 needs more time be thought through, looking at New York State Ag overtime might be a great starting point. Please reconsider this current bill and give it more time to thought through. With workers hours being cut down to 40-hours there will be more people looking for second jobs. The part of that worries me is the safety of employees having two jobs, tired and in a rush to get to another job.
