From the Department of Justice website.

(a)(1) It shall be unlawful for any Federal, State or local government agency to deny to any individual any right, benefit, or privilege provided by law because of such individual's refusal to disclose his social security account number.

This bill clearly violates this rule of law denying these rights.

Any one registering to VOTE must be required to show valid proof of identity and address to register. Using ones SS# IN ANY WAY is not valid proof of identity nor allowed by law.

Allowing anyone to register in anyway other then in person would allow for voter fraud.
