I am writing to you today in support of farmworker overtime. Farmworkers should receive overtime pay after 40 hours in a workweek at one and one-half times the employee's regular rate of pay.

I write to you today as a descendent of farm workers. I also am, like you, and like each of us, someone who benefits from the labor of farmworkers every day. Farmworkers deserve dignity, respect and labor rights. For too long they have been denied rights other workers have been afforded.

Overtime pay law was created to discourage employers from overworking employees. Farmworkers are a particularly vulnerable class of workers due to the prevalence of language barriers. Before 1938, employers overworked workers even to the point of death. Exclusion from overtime pay requires farmworkers to work many hours without having time to do other things.

It is time for Oregon to join several other states in ending this racist practice of excluding agricultural workers from overtime pay. Thank you!

I urge you to pass farmworker overtime in the 2022 Legislative Session to ensure farmworkers in Oregon are paid fairly for their skilled and essential labor.
