> Overtime pay law was created to discourage employers from overworking employees, and to compensate workers for their extended labor. Before 1938, employers overworked workers even to the point of death. Exclusion from overtime pay requires farm workers to work many hours without having time to do other things, like be with their families.

> It is time for Oregon to join several other states in ending this racist practice of excluding agricultural workers from overtime pay.

>

> I urge you to pass farmworker overtime in the 2022 Legislative Session to ensure farmworkers in Oregon are paid fairly for their skilled and essential labor.
