They have a well-founded fear of persecution and records to document the events, but are trying to raise money for an attorney to present their case.

SB 1543 could provide the legal representation they need without having to raise thousands of dollars. The bill could help hundreds of other Central Oregonians who perform essential jobs in our economy, but face circumstances where they need legal help to avert a deportation. They are part of our community and deserve low-cost or free legal help to keep their families from being split apart.
