Taken from the Text of [HB 4035], "SECTION 1. (1) The Oregon Health Authority shall conduct a study and recommend potential options to improve access to or lower the cost of health care in this state. Based on the findings of the study, the authority shall implement the recommendations to the extent consistent with the agency's existing statutory authority.

(2) No later than September 15, 2023, the authority shall report to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to health any legislative changes necessary to fully

implement the recommendations under subsection (1) of this section."
