The Oregon Wildlife Coalition - nine organizations advocating for wildlife conservation - continues to oppose House Bill 4080. We submitted detailed written comments for the February 9 meeting of the House Committee on Environment and Natural Resources, which are hereby incorporated by reference, and submit these additional comments for the February 14 meeting.

HB 4080 was originally scheduled for public hearing February 9. In connection with that meeting, 106 groups and individuals submitted written testimony (including those submitting testimony jointly). Of those, 82 (77 percent) opposed the bill.

The hearing scheduled for February 9 was carried over to February 14. Thus, all testimony submitted for the February 9 hearing should be considered in connection with the February 14 hearing.
