SECTION 12. (1) The Environmental Justice Council with staff support from the Department of Environmental Quality, in collaboration with the office of Enterprise Information Services, the Institute for Natural Resources, the Portland State University Population Research Center, and natural resource agencies with staff support from the department and the Oregon Health Authority, shall develop an environmental justice mapping tool... **[Hidden costs all over the place-including hiring more staff with corresponding overheads.]

SECTION 18. (1) The Department of Environmental Quality and the Oregon Health Authority shall develop the environmental justice mapping tool under section 12 of this 2022 Act no later than September 15, 2025... **[updating-more and more hidden costs. Maps will change periodically, requiring more and more money.]
