Taken from the Text of [HB 4027], '... (c) Must be surrounded by a nonelectric perimeter fence or wall that is not less than five feet in height; (d) May not be higher than the greater of 10 feet in height or two feet higher than the height of the nonelectric perimeter fence or wall...'

The costs and height restrictions of the electrified fence are unacceptable and will deter use.

The goal with the electric fence is to deter and not to molly coddle the criminal element.
