

SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

Construction Contractors Board Revenue, Staffing, and IT System Update

On February 17th, the General Government Subcommittee recommended acknowledging receipt of a report from the Construction Contractors Board on revenue, staffing, and a new IT system.

In the 2021 long session the Construction Contractors Board was given a directive to return to the Legislature during the 2022 legislative session to report on:

- Actual and projected revenues for the 2021-23 and 2023-25 biennium;
- Give an updated timeline and proposal for resourcing a new licensing system; and,
- Give a review of the agency's staffing needs.

The report provides updates on revenue projections including a six-month projected ending fund balance; as well as an estimated timeline for provisioning replacement of the agency's license system with an implementation goal of December 2024; and a preliminary assessment of the agency's long-term staffing needs.

The General Government Subcommittee recommends approval.
