**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
SENATE BILL 1564**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 27.

2 On page 2, delete lines 1 and 2 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:**

4 **“(a) ‘Grow site’ has the meaning given that term by the State De-**  
5 **partment of Agriculture by rule.**

6 **“(b) ‘Industrial hemp’ has the meaning given that term in ORS**  
7 **571.269.**

8 **“(c) ‘Research grower license’ has the meaning given that term by**  
9 **the department by rule.**

10 **“(2)(a) The governing body of a county that, pursuant to ORS**  
11 **401.309, declares a state of emergency related to cannabis may notify**  
12 **the State Department of Agriculture of the declaration and request**  
13 **that the department deny the issuance of grower licenses under ORS**  
14 **571.281, including to applicants that submitted applications for grower**  
15 **licenses under ORS 571.281 on or after January 1, 2022, and prior to the**  
16 **effective date of this 2022 Act, for grow sites located in an area subject**  
17 **to the jurisdiction of the county.**

18 **“(b) A declaration of a state of emergency described in paragraph**  
19 **(a) of this subsection must:**

20 **“(A) Be for a duration that includes the entire growing season for**  
21 **industrial hemp, as determined by the department; and**

1       **“(B) Include a statement that denying the issuance of grower li-**  
2 **enses under ORS 571.281 as described in paragraph (a) of this sub-**  
3 **section may alleviate the conditions giving rise to the declaration.**

4       **“(c) The notification described in paragraph (a) of this subsection**  
5 **must be:**

6       **“(A) Made annually for each year during which the governing body**  
7 **of a county declares a state of emergency as described in paragraph**  
8 **(a) of this subsection; and**

9       **“(B) Received by the department:**

10       **“(i) Not later than March 15, 2022, for the 2022 growing season; and**

11       **“(ii) Not later than January 1, 2023, for the 2023 growing season.**

12       **“(3) When the department receives the notice and request described**  
13 **in this section, the department shall deny the issuance of grower li-**  
14 **enses under ORS 571.281 as described in subsection (2) of this section.**

15       **“(4) Notwithstanding subsection (3) of this section, the department**  
16 **may issue a grower license under ORS 571.281 for a grow site located**  
17 **in an area subject to the jurisdiction of a county described in sub-**  
18 **section (2) of this section if the applicant held a valid grower license**  
19 **or registration under ORS 571.281 during the 2020 or 2021 calendar year.**

20       **“(5) The department may adopt rules to carry out this section.**

21       **“(6) This section does not apply to research grower licenses.**

22       **“SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2022 Act is repealed on June 30,**  
23 **2023.”.**

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
