OREGON TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION

- Appointed by Governor; confirmed by State Senate
- Five members
 - Geographic representation
 - Balanced political affiliation
- Four-year terms
- Governor-appointed Chair; Chair-appointed Vice Chair

ROLE OF COMMISSION



- Develop and maintain statewide transportation policy
- Appoint Director
- Approve budget, plans, STIP
- Collaborate across Oregon, West coast

OTC STRATEGIC ACTION PLAN

- Equity
- Sufficient and Reliable Funding
- Modern Transportation System



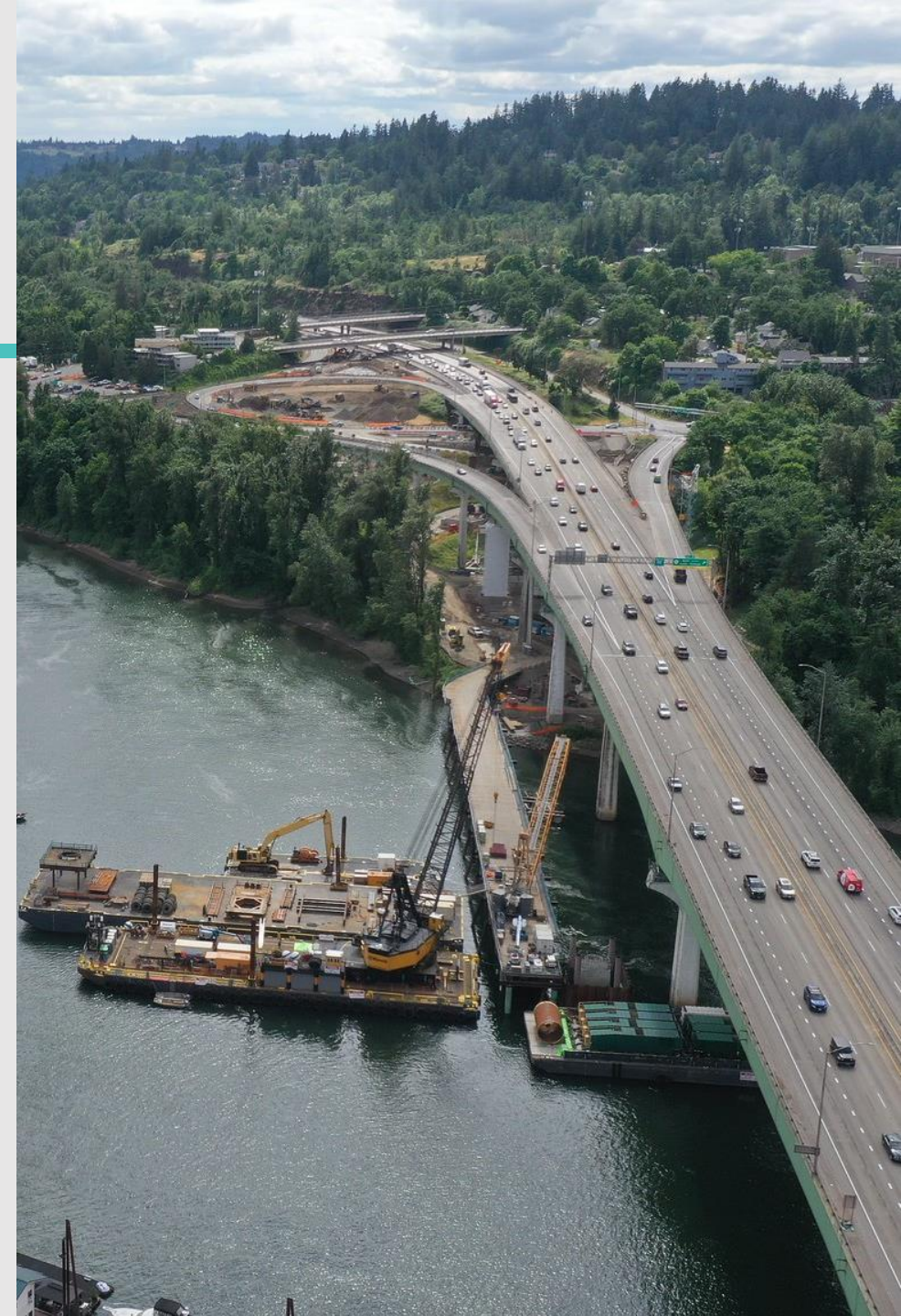


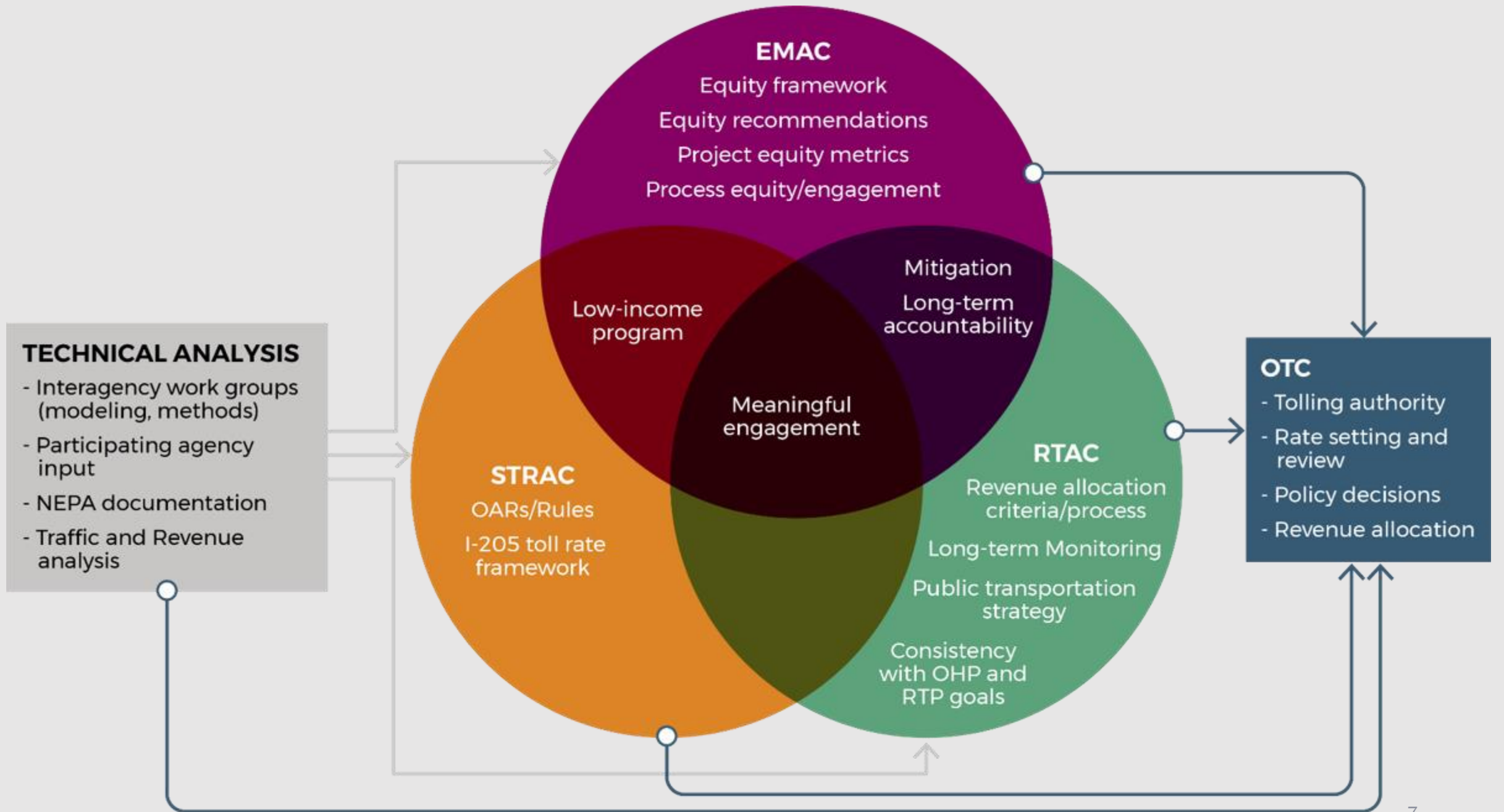
HB 2017

- HB 2017 envisioned a more engaged OTC
 - Legislation bolstered the Commission's authority
 - Directed Commission to provide more oversight and direction to ODOT
- Strategic Action Plan implements that direction
