Community College Concerns

- OSAC has moved away from looking at full cost of attendance and to only tuition and institutional fees and costs.
- The OSAC financial aid framework funds a lower share of most community college students' cost of attendance, which would likely grow with further implementation.
- The framework negates the modest financial benefit PELL gives to students attending lower-cost institutions.
- Investing less in aid for community college students reinforces systemic inequities.



Community College Students and the Oregon Opportunity Grant

- Base award amounts on total cost of attendance.
- At minimum, maintain equity in cost-of-attendance funding for students at lower-cost institutions.
- Rescind rule that students must attend in the fall to receive aid in the winter and spring.
