




### Map Key

- The number on the pin indicates the number of program sites located in the region.








## Residential Treatment Homes (RTH)

- Capacity: up to 5 residents
- Security: Unlocked
- Lower acuity, clients may be under the jurisdiction of the PSRB or stepping down from high levels of care
- Includes Crisis Respite: Short-term stability supports for individual experience a mental health crisis




