Activated projects beyond the legislation




HB 2017 funds allowed ODOT to pursue the 21 named construction projects in the legislation and has activated the development of more than 115 additional projects.

As of fall 2023, more than 70% of these projects are already under construction or completed.







Status:

- Phase 1: Complete
- Phase 2: 95% complete, permanent striping in 2024

Location:

- Phase 1: Conifer Blvd. to Merloy Avenue
- Phase 2: Independence Hwy to past Garland Nursery

Work:

• Safety Improvements to reduce crashes in the corridor.

Contractor:

- Phase 1: HP Civil Inc.
- Phase 2: North Santiam Paving

Funding:

• Total budget: \$28.2 million (\$20 million HB 2017)



Status:

- Construction starts November 2023
- Estimated completion in fall 2024

Location:

- 3 bridges east of City of Rouge River on OR 99
 - Birdseye Creek, Foots Creek, Millers Gulch

Work:

Replace 3 bridges with earthquake ready bridges

Contractor:

• Carter and Company, Inc.

Funding:

• \$11.7 million (HB 2017)





US 97/US 20: Bend North Corridor

Status:

- Construction started November 2022
- Estimated completion in fall 2024

Location and Work:


- 2 roundabouts, multi-use paths, pedestrian crossings on US 20
- Realignment, multi-use path, pedestrian crossings on US 97
- Transit stop, ADA ramps

Contractor:

• Kiewit Infrastructure West Co.

Funding:

 \$180 million includes: \$50 million HB 2017, \$60 million Federal INFRA grant, \$20 million City of Bend and Deschutes County, plus other funding



BICYCLE, PEDESTRIAN AND ADA IMPROVEMENTS

Construct multi-use paths and sidewalks, including a 12 foot wide path from Empire to Cooley Road

Construct new marked pedestrian crossings including raised medians and Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons (RRFB)

Upgrade all ADA curb ramps

Add, upgrade, and widen bike lanes

Add a new transit stop along Robal Lane

ROADWAY AND INTERSECTION UPGRADES

Build a new section of U.S. 97 near the railroad tracks

The current U.S. 97 becomes future 3rd Street

Create roundabouts where U.S. 20 meets Robal Lane and Cooley Road

Status:

- Construction started early 2023
- Estimated completion by end of 2023

Location and Work:

- Roundabout in Tumalo at US 20/Cook Ave
- Roundabout at US 20/ Old Bend Redmond Highway
- US 20 pavement preservation, multi-use paths, and pedestrian undercrossing in Tumalo

Contractor:

• Markum & Sons, LLC

Funding:

• \$27 million (\$3 million HB 2017)

Status:

- Construction started early 2023
- Estimated completion by fall 2024

Location and Work:


- Pave pull outs between Riley Junction and Ontario
- Safety upgrades at six intersections along US 20
- US 20/OR 201 Cairo Junction roundabout

Contractor:

• Markum & Sons, LLC

Funding:

• \$16.7 million (\$10 million HB 2017)

Eastern Oregon Preservation Work: I-84 Frontage Road: Meacham Cr & UPRR Bridge

Status:

- Bidding in summer 2024
- Estimated completion fall 2025

Location and Work:

 Replace existing bridge over Meacham Creek and the UPRR line and add additional roadway width to provide a two-way road

Funding:

• \$7 million (project was only funded to PE and HB 2017 provided funding for construction)



Eastern Oregon Preservation Work: US 95: Blue Mountain - McDermitt

Status:

- Construction anticipated spring 2024
- Estimated completion late summer 2025

Location and Work:

• 22.7 miles of paving, shoulder work, rumble strips, and delineators along US 95

Contractor:

High Desert Aggregate & Paving Inc

Funding:

• \$14 million (\$1.16 million HB 2017)
