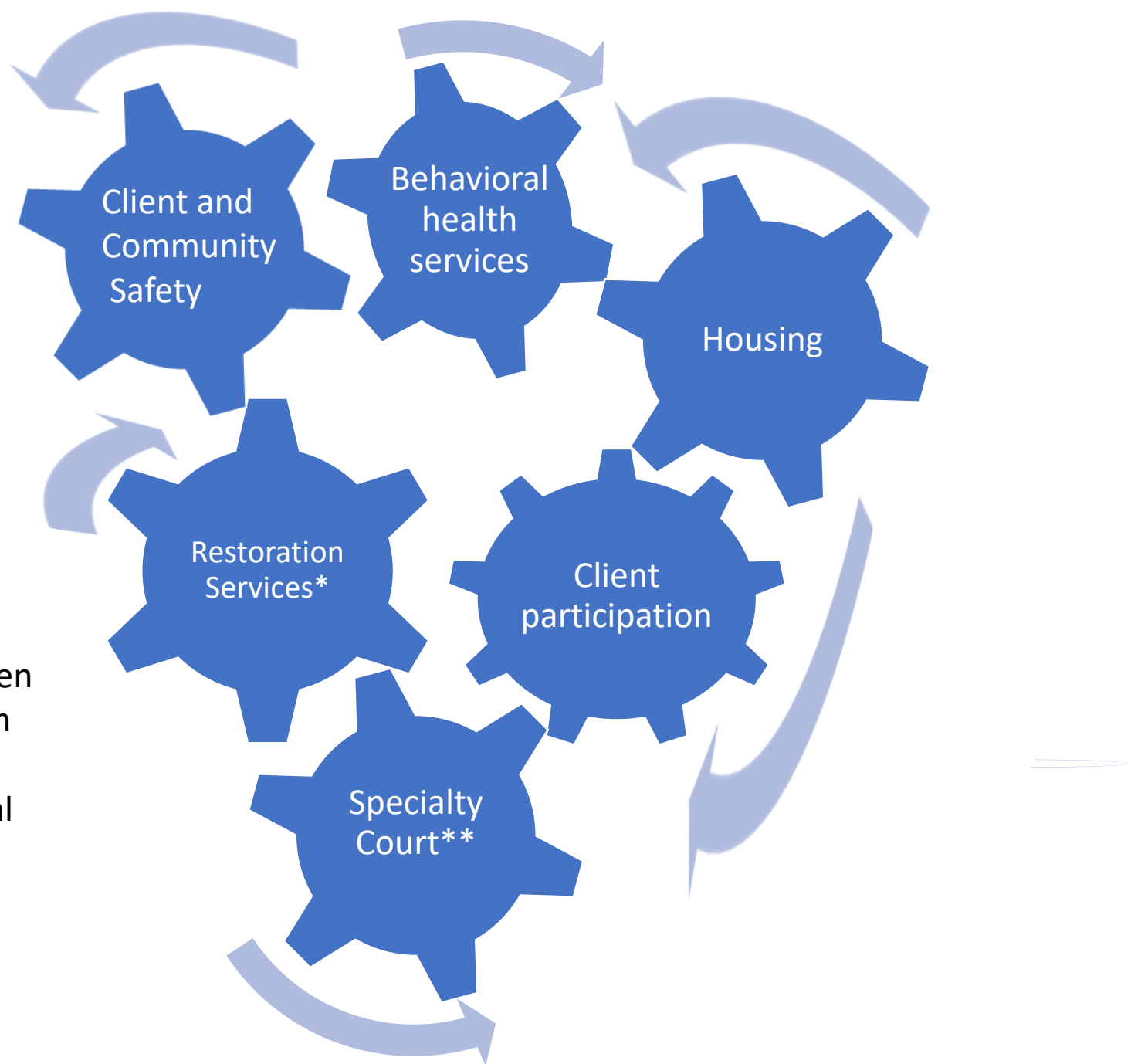

Restoration Services

Washington County Aid and Assist Services

Program Coordinator: Administers the program; is the liaison to system partners - court, DA's Office, Defense Bar, Sherriff's Office, Oregon State Hospital. Assigns and conducts court ordered evaluations.

Jail-based 370 Case Manager: Identify AIC's experiencing significant symptoms of mental illness, coordinates necessary jail and OSH diversion resources and identifies those with potential for Community Restoration and/or referrals to the county mental health Director's Designee for a civil commitment investigation. Provides in-jail support for those returning from OSH and to assist with transitions back into the community.

370 Court Case Manager: Works within the court to support the Aid and Assist docket, including facilitating rapid (SB24-related) court meetings to discuss all potential "actions" (dismissal, commitment, CR, OSH) for each case; provide "rapid evaluation" screenings (and refer to that program), CR assessments, and facilitate the NMI process as appropriate. Works with jail diversion staff, the jail medical and community mental health providers to alert them of those in need of service linkage.

Restoration Services continued:

OSH 370 Court Liaison: Monitors client progress towards transition from OHA and restoration. Provides updates to the court and collaborates the OSH 370 Coordinator. Evaluates ongoing for potential Community Restoration. Reports directly to the court. Coordinates services for RTP OSH patients.

OSH 370 Care Coordinator: Coordinates care for OSH 370 clients. Collaborates with the OSH court liaison on advocating for least restrictive alternatives of care and to prepare for transfers back to jail custody.

CR Monitor: Monitors the progress of Community Restoration clients. Provides legal skills training. Reports to the court. Alerts attorneys and court if/when safety concerns arise. Attends hearings.

CR Care Coordinator: Coordinates care for Community Restoration clients. Collaborates with the CR Monitor and Court Case Manager on advocating for least restrictive alternatives of care and timely criminal case resolution.
