

## **Distribution of Gross Incomes of Enrolled ERDC Families**



The currently average monthly income of families using ERDC is \$2,444, or \$29,328/year.



## Number of New Cases that Are Categorically Eligible





2,114 categorically eligible families have enrolled in ERDC between July 1 and October 31, 2023. These are primarily families receiving TANF who became eligible for ERDC July 1<sup>st</sup>.
