I believe very much in the intent of prop 110, but it has been such a complete failure for those of us living in proximity to the camps of addicts that have become a ubiquitous part of Portland life. While it isn't an everyday occurrence that I have had to pass by people openly injecting or smoking out of foil pipes as I walk my child to or from first grade, it has been frequent enough that I no longer find it surprising.

Prop 110 needs to be amended to require treatment rather than jail and should be suspended completely until Oregon builds enough treatment facilities to handle the need.
