Measure 110 is broken. It is enabling suffering, addiction, and contributes greatly to homeless camps throughout our state. Leaving addicts on our street then contributes to crime as these addicts commit crimes to support their addictions.

Please update M110 to require drug treatment and if treatment is refused (all addicts have been refusing treatment because there is no consequence), there must be a suitable penalty, such as prison. If addicts are mentally ill, the state must have the power to incarcerate or hospitalize.
