Rite Aid is just closing on NE 41 Avenue, Target has closed on NE Halsey and Aunt Tillie's Deli is now closing at y pm and earlier because of the druggies hanging around the area. Just three examples The empty storefronts are making my neighborhood an eye sore not to mention causing me to go elsewhere to purchase items. They are driving people away from our area. I encourage you to do the following:

Make possession of lethal drugs such as fentanyl, heroin and methamphetamines are misdemeanor crime again.

Give Law enforcement the tools to steer adicts toward mandatory treatment and away from jail. Prioritize diversion programs that put drug users on the path to recovery and a clean criminal record Increase penalties for drug dealing and public drug use Take Legislative action in February. People are dying each day under Measure 110
