

Measure 110 has been disastrous for Oregon. We need to reimplement the law that requires people to get treatment or go to jail. I understand there is a desire not to criminalize addiction, however, this is leading to open drug usage and a lack of safety for others in the community including children. The fruit of this measure has been bad.

I want to express my support for the re-criminalization of drugs, mandatory treatment or jail time, and banning public drug use. I believe this can be done quickly in February and is necessary for Oregon to solve the open-air drug use, prioritize safe communities, help the homeless crisis, and allow police the tools to stop deadly hard drugs from permeating our communities.
