For the last three years I have experienced a terrifying increase in DIRECT threats to my personal safety living and working in multhomah county.

From the people too incoherent to know that they're walking directly out into traffic and nearly getting run over, to being accosted by a man wielding garden shears in the parking garage at my job (Kaiser Permanente North Interstate), I don't know how much longer I can rationally allow myself and my family to live in Portland.

Everyday, driving from my home in NW to my job in North Portland, I see dozens of tents, trash everywhere, the occasional massive fire among the tents, and at least several people on the side walk or in the middle of the road )and four times in the last three years banging on my car window when I was at a stop light on Burnside) screaming out of their minds.

This city has become a terrifying place, and decriminalizing drug use has been a major contributor.

PLEASE abolish measure 110.
