It is 100000000x worse than it was before and yet so much \$\$\$\$ was given to make it better. Not only does this need to be repealed, all that \$\$\$ needs to be accounted for. On a personal note, I have a son with autism. He walks and takes Trimet. He would be unaware if he came in contact with dealing drugs, taking drugs, overdosing from drugs and all the crime that comes from it. He could walk into something and get hurt or worse. As a state, we need to take our power back and put an end to this measure before we have no state left! Karen Cook
