I have personally seen drugged out people sprawled all over sandy blvd, body on the sidewalk and heads in the road. I own a business by the airport and many customers don't want to come by anymore, as an RV full of homeless have made a permanent home outside. They smoke fentanyl and pass out on the side of the road as customers are driving in. I've heard many comment about "they are smoking out of foil outside right now" and it's embarrassing as I work on high end dollar vehicles. Nobody wants to leave their cars with me as they fear these cracked out people will break in and steal.

There are also 2 very young kids that run around the street when the parents are passed out on the ground, last week they chased me with an ax. I fear my life, I fear my business will close down and I fear that one day those kids will die. Measure 110 needs to be revoked. There's no way around it. Revoke measure 110. The only option Portland's are left with is to move out of the city and to another county. Multnomah county will run dry and have no resources or money left.
