

Hello, Oregon legislators.

I am a constituent living in inner SE Portland. I voted in favor of Measure 110 when it came up for a vote, but I now am of the opinion that it SHOULD DEFINITELY BE REPEALED. I believe that we were misguided to think that decriminalizing drugs without significant (and costly) infrastructure in place to support and rehabilitate users would possibly be helpful to individuals. I have seen the total devastation to so many lives as the crisis of drug use has only escalated in our city partly as a result of eliminating legal disincentives for active use/possession. My son and I go downtown twice per week, and we consistently witness the inhumanity that this law has caused - fellow human beings passed out on our sidewalks suffering in their drug-induced hazes, human waste (feces) in public areas, having to pass through fentanyl smoke on our way to my son's medical appointments as people actively use, etc. The mission of Measure 110 has been a failure - a failure to improve the health of Oregonians and a failure to reduce societal costs. Please represent me in REPEALING Measure 110.
