This ill conceived measure has done nothing but damage Oregon communities, and has led to Oregon becoming a destination for those wanting to live a lifestyle of drug use without consequence.

Recriminalizing open drug use is a good start, but the entire measure needs to be repealed. Overdose deaths have increased dramatically. Emergency services are stretched beyond their limits, and often times tax paying citizens who need these services (that they pay for) are suffering due to their unavailability.

The experiment failed, horribly. Completely reversing course is both wise and moral.
