I urge you to fix this law. I have been helping clean up the city of Portland over the last several years with SOLVE and have ridden my bike close to 4000 miles this year, most of it in Portland. I ride on the springwater Trail and the 205 path on a regular basis and I see what measure 110 has done to the city of Portland and to the homeless that are affected by it. People with drug problems will not seek help on their own. They need to be encouraged or incentived to get help. We need to send a message that doing drugs openly in the streets of Portland is not OK.
