As a small business owner in downtown Portland Proposition 110 has been a disaster. I see people openly shooting up drugs on the street, not caring that they are being seen. I've also seen people smoking crack and fentanyl on the streets, why not - there is no consequence.

This is a failed proposition that was funded by out of state lobbyists and has created an even greater social problem for Oregonians. Having consequences such as jail or getting your kids taken away motivates drug users to get help, but when there are no consequences they continue the same self destructive behavior.

I want to see Proposition 110 repealed, the sooner the better.
