As a daily bike commuter across the steel bridge and thru old town in PDX I am constantly amazed at the squalor, open drug use, and lives being wasted on our streets.

Primary behaviors that I see on my morning and evening rides are:

- people rambling incoherently
- people passed out on the sidewalk
- people urinating or defecating in the street
- people arguing or negotiating for drugs
- people actively smoking fentanyl

The situation is apparently completely unregulated and getting worse.

Measure 110 has not worked and these people are the primary victims. However the damage is not limited to them. Our city is sustaining serious damage and wasting our common resources, reputation, and potential on this failed social experiment.

Please work to refine or reverse measure 110 to bring real consequences for these actions and active support for victims to clean up and make our streets safe again.
