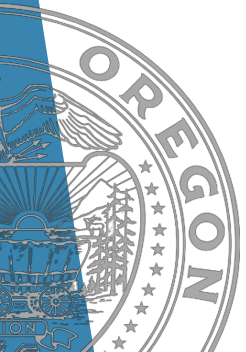

## *Retrospective:*



Oregon Cybersecurity Plan approved by CISA/FEMA.



Year 1 funding allocated, and full match waiver granted.



Statewide Cybersecurity services catalog is drafted and prioritized in tiers by the planning committee.



Grant application processing framework completed.



Grant application registration website stood up.



Registration and application submission deadlines set.

Registration Deadline set for November 15, 2023

Proposal submission deadline set to January 10, 2024.

₧ FFY23 grant funding approval notice received.

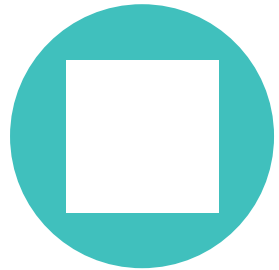

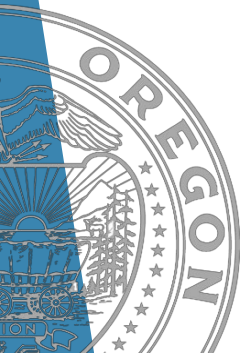

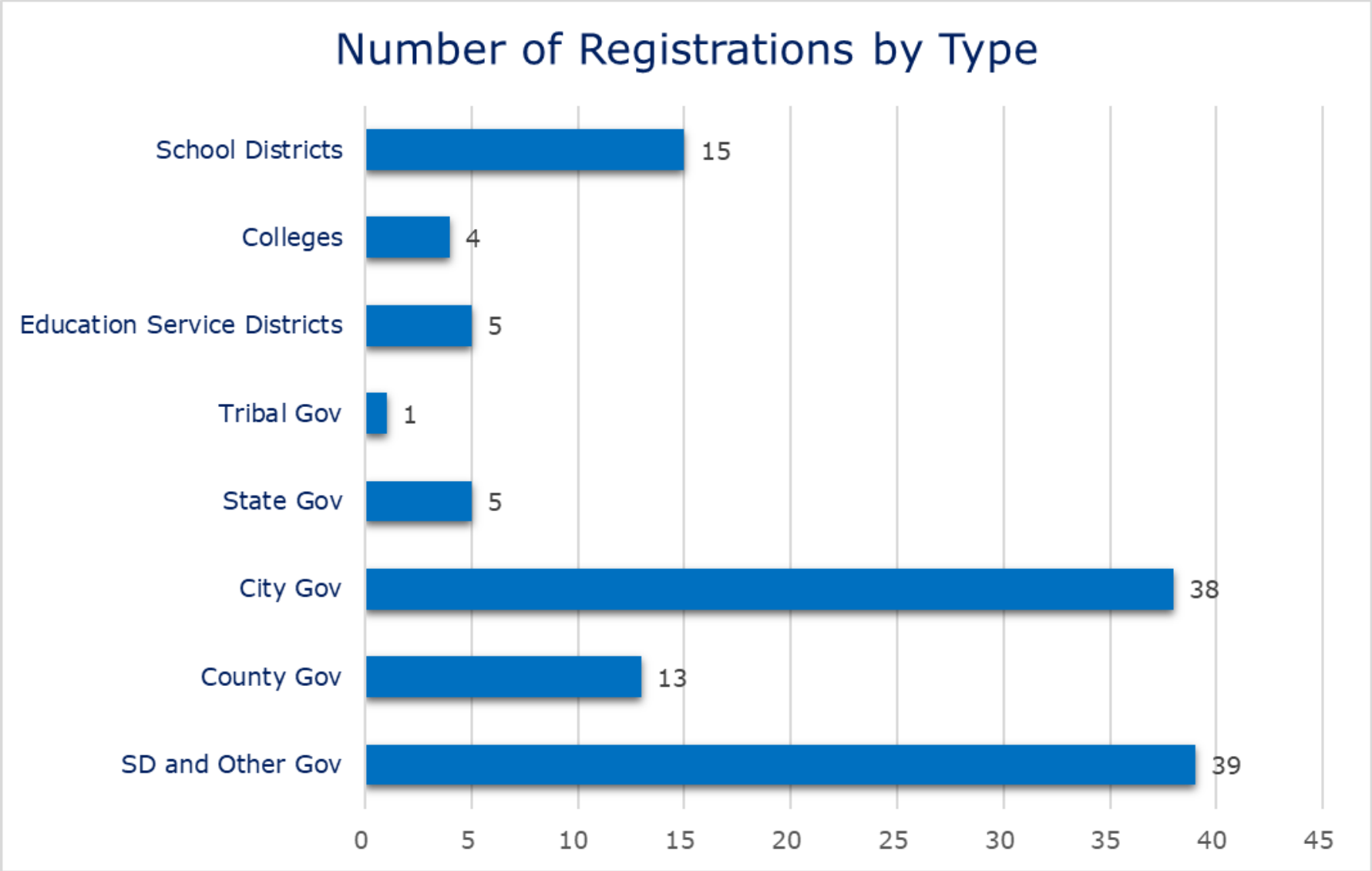

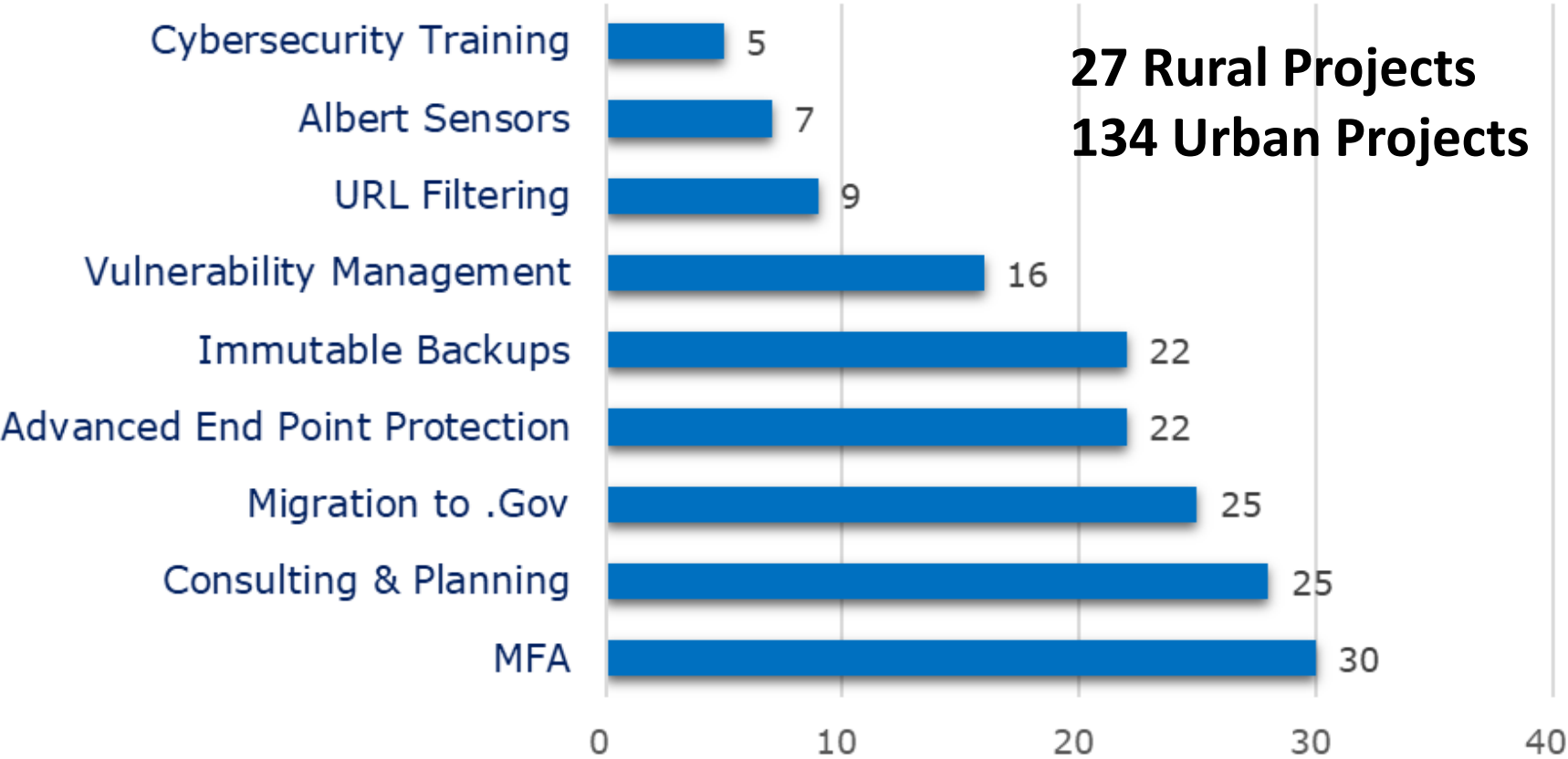


# IIJA SLCGP: FFY22 – FFY23 Registration Breakdown

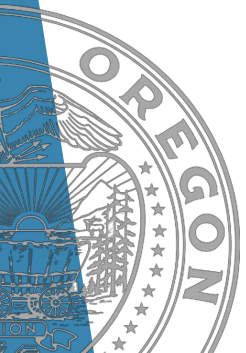

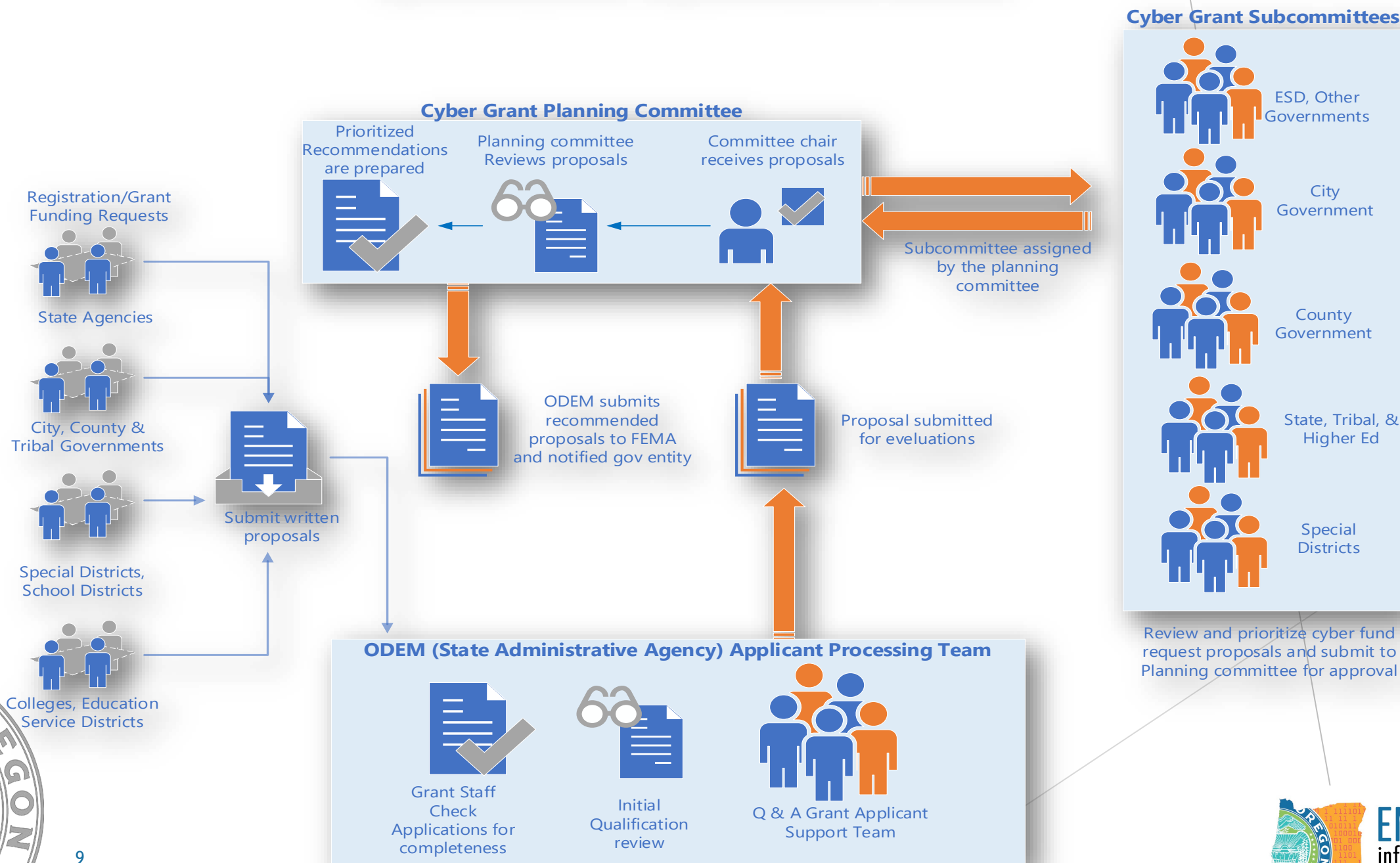
