SUMMARY

Digest: Makes BOLI study and report on laws that allow workers to take job-protected time off from work. (Flesch Readability Score: 65.1).

Requires the Bureau of Labor and Industries to study issues related to the different federal and state laws under which a worker may take job-protected leave from work for qualifying reasons. Requires the bureau to submit a report to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to labor and business not later than September 15, 2025.

2 Relating to laws concerning job-protected leave from work.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Bureau of Labor and Industries shall study issues**
5 **related to the different federal and state laws under which workers**
6 **may take job-protected leave from work for qualifying reasons. The**
7 **bureau shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245,**
8 **and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim**
9 **committees of the Legislative Assembly related to labor and business**
10 **no later than September 15, 2025.**

11 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2024 Act is repealed on January 2, 2026.**
