




Early Literacy in Early Learning

HB 3198: Birth Through Five Literacy Plan & Fund

Budget Note directs DELC to develop a plan to:

- Expand culturally specific early literacy programs for children from birth to age 5
- Provide training and coaching for direct service staff in early literacy
- Develop and expand language revitalization efforts by federally recognized Tribes

Recommendations

Leverage existing program infrastructure so funds reach community quickly.

Kindergarten Partnership & Innovation \$4.7 million

- Professional development (PD) for the early learning workforce focused on developmentally appropriate literacy and literacy supports
- Parent engagement and supports to promote literacy at home

Birth Through Five Literacy Program \$4.7 million

- Early Childhood Equity Fund eligibility
- Parent engagement and supports to promote literacy at home
- Culturally-relevant PD for early educators
- Engagement to identify community-specific literacy gaps



Dolly Parton's Imagination Library

- \$1.7M allocated to DELC for the Imagination Library program for 2023-25
- DELC is working on a direct contract to operate the Imagination Library of Oregon Program
- The contractor will establish 36 county-based local partners enrolling children in the program
- DELC will pay 50% and the remaining 50% of cost comes from local partners





October – December 2023: Scoping direct award

January – February 2024: Finalize negotiations for direct award

March 2024: Begin contract for Imagination Library of Oregon services
