## SUMMARY

Digest: The Act requires the OHA to study drug use in this state and to send a report on its findings to the legislature. The Act is repealed on January 2, 2026. (Flesch Readability Score: 65.5).

Requires the Oregon Health Authority to study Oregon's addiction crisis. Directs the authority to submit findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to health not later than September 15, 2025.

Sunsets on January 2, 2026.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to addiction.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Oregon Health Authority shall study addiction in**  
5 **Oregon. The authority shall submit a report in the manner provided**  
6 **by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to**  
7 **the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to health**  
8 **no later than September 15, 2025.**

9 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2024 Act is repealed on January 2, 2026.**
