Tackling Administrative Burden

WRAPAROUND

Intensive Care Coordination for Children

- 3 additional separate data entry platforms
- Double documentation in two of those platforms
- Quarterly and annual reporting of duplicate information to the CCO
- Clients randomly assigned twice annually to two required activities with associated forms and additional hours of observation and documentation

EASA

Early Assessment & Support Alliance - First Episode Psychosis Treatment Program

- 1 additional database with extensive duplicate information entered for each individual served
- 4 separate quarterly reporting requirements
- Fidelity Review every two years requiring steps similar to those on previous slide – site visits, observations, interviews, chart audits, etc.

MCIS

Mobile Crisis Intervention Services

- 40+ item separate data entry spreadsheet to record data on every client, every time they are served – nearly half of the fields are duplicate information to Electronic Medical Record (EMR) and to OHA Measures and Outcomes Tracking System (MOTS).
- Quarterly and annual reporting

Double/Triple Documentation

- Additional data entry and documentation is completed for each individual served and in addition to clinical documentation requirements for every client.
- Measures and Outcomes Tracking System (MOTS)* data duplicates much of this data and is required for all individuals served.

**Under Revision*

Duplicative Certification Processes

- Over 2,000 hours of services to clients a year
- Over 2,500 hours of overall staff time a year
- Annual cost of approximately \$440,000

200 staff hours - \$9,630

60 client hours - \$9,000

Certified Community BH Clinic (CBBHC) Certificate Renewal

1,342 staff hours - \$58,936

1,219 client hours - \$182,850

3,232 staff hours - \$140,206

3,109 client hours - \$466,350

Annual Coordinated Care Organization (CCO) Site Review

47 staff hours
